

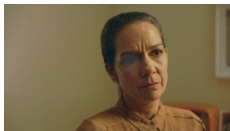

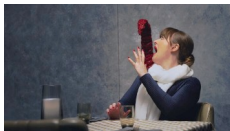
A couple engaged in a bizarre legal proceeding confront the source of their problem.

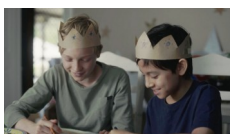
The Fling | 4m | 2025
